Bring the Book Box Back to Your Classroom!

Shipping books to the classroom helps teachers create a monthly in-class event to get students excited about reading.

1 Make sure you have selected 'Yes' when asked if you are running Book Clubs. Teachers who are running Book Clubs must accept consolidated classroom orders.

2 Share the flyers and your Class Code with families. Set a due date for the classroom order. You will receive an email every time a family places an order.


3 When parents shop from Book Clubs they:

- Can shop from thousands of items available online.
- Can ship books to the classroom, or choose to ship right to their home.
- Submit their order and payment online.

4 When the set due date arrives, add your own orders to the cart, and submit everything as a combined classroom order. Parents receive an email when the classroom order has been submitted. Combined classroom orders over \$40 will ship to the school for FREE. Classroom orders less than \$40 cost only \$7.50 to ship.

5 The combined classroom order will ship right to the school. You will receive a packing slip with students' names and their items to make distribution easy.

6 Shop and use your Rewards to choose from thousands of the best children's books at the right level in both English and French. You can redeem your rewards on anything you need for your classroom!


Talk to other teachers and run the Book Clubs program together!

Earning Rewards
